## Proof Highlights

With the final Genetic Evaluation round of the year, EastGen has been able to fortify our line-up with new sires. Of special note, we have decided to extend our popular **Immunity+ Special** until the Spring and we have introduced a new **Polled Special** which should draw a lot of attention. Our proof list offers remarkable value for every type of breeder with any herd goal in mind.

HOLSTEIN: Progenesis Monteverdi, who joined our proven line-up with a GMACE proof last proof round, now has an official Canadian type proof with +8 for Conformation (up a point). Monteverdi is made for today's dairymen as a value-add profit driver. He is currently +3628 GMACE LPI, \$2520 Pro\$, +930 Milk, +98 Fat (+.51%), and +62 Protein (+.25%). He is an A2A2 carrier and he is the #1 ranked Robot Ready™ designated sire for Calving Ability (111), Semen Fertility (+63), and for Feet & Legs with a +10 overall! Another perfect option to use on your Ranger-Red bloodlines is our newly added **Jeanlu Brisk-PP VRED \*RC**. Being homozygous for the polled gene means that 100% of **Brisk-PP** progeny will be polled. **Brisk-PP** debuts with +3418 GPA LPI, +846 Milk, +52 Fat (+.15%), +27 Protein (-.01%) and a pleasing +11 for Conformation. A Zircon-P son, the impressive **Brisk-PP**

AYRSHIRE: Two new Ayrshire additions this proof round starting with the #2 ranked GPA LPI sire Kildare Marcus. He is a Magellan son from a high producing and testing VG-86 Valpas from 5 generations of VG dams from the globally recognized matriarch of the Kildare Master Breeder herd 'Heligo Xante EX-90'. Robot Ready™ designated and an A2A2 carrier, Marcus will bring solid production (+1211 Milk), positive deviations (+.08% for both Fat & Protein), dairy power (+10 Dairy Strength) and a pleasing health profile. A 2X Silver Award winner, Bagel was also the 1st 5-YR at the 2023 WDE and Res. Grand Ch. at the 2022 RAWF National Show. She is also a maternal sister to dam of the popular sire Bowlers. Bagel's dam, Dulet Joel Brioche EX-95 3E 4\*, won All-Canadian honours in 2017 and was All-Quebec three years in a row. Behind Brioche is an EX-2E with two All-Canadian nominations and 3 Gold Awards. The family continues with a VG-86, EX-2E, EX-93-4E 4\* (with 3 All-Canadian nominations & one H.M All-Canadian), EX-93-3E 2\* (with 2 All-Canadian nominations), VG-87, and an EX 9th dam! With +19 for type and exceptional deviations (+.71% Fat,+.25% Protein), Mr Brown is going to become a household name in the Jersey world very quickly.

Moshpit-P debuts with +1808 GPA LPI, +623 Milk, +59 Fat (+.38%), +37 Protein (+.19%) and +9 for Conformation and Mammary System. He will make a great addition as a production and Health & Fertility specialist. Our last addition, Greenmoor **Tenacious-P**, is also heterozygous Polled. This Broadband-P son is from a Chief (6) daughter from an EX-3E Change Up from an EX 4\* Joel. Tenacious-P debuts with +820 Milk, +67 Fat (+.30%), +37 Protein (+.06%) and +9 for type. He will make a nice addition to our growing list of Polled sires and will be a great source of Dairy Strength (+12) for cows requiring more depth and width throughout.

**GUERNSEY:** The Toledo son **Springhill Jigsaw** joins our Guernsey line-up with +861 GPA LPI. His dam, Springhill Mentor Joice EX-95 (EX-96 MS), was a 2X All-American in 2019 & 2021 and Res. All-American in 2023.

**MILKING SHORTHORN:** No new sires for our Milking Shorthorns but the long awaited era of genomic proofs has now become a reality for the breed, which is exciting.

John Schenkels, Zone 1 Director (Newfoundland-Labrador, P.E.I., New Brunswick)

John Schenkels operates a dairy farm at Whitney, NB, where he and his family manage 1000 acres and milk 200 cows in a parlour/freestall setup. The Holstein herd is known by the Miramichi prefix, and the operation is supported by four family members and 13 employees. Additionally, John is a partner in a second dairy operation near Salisbury, NB, which milks 350 cows in a robotic setup.

A graduate of Nova Scotia Agricultural College, John returned to the family farm some 30 years ago to join his parents, who had emigrated from the Netherlands in 1959. The farm has garnered several accolades, including being named New Brunswick's Farm of the Year in 2012. In 2023, the herd achieved the #3 ranking for Herd Performance in the province according to Lactanet. The Miramichi herd is 100% Semex sired, with the farm utilizing breeding tools such as Elevate® and OptiMate™, as well as more than 80% Immunity+® sires.

John currently serves as the chair of Milk 2020 and is involved with Dairy Farmers of New Brunswick. He looks forward to bringing his experience and unique perspective to EastGen, guiding the organization as it moves forward.

Lee Grant, Zone 4 Director (Frontenac, Grenville, Lanark, Leeds, Renfrew)

Lee Grant is from Leeds County, and farms at Chaffey's Lock near Elgin, ON. They milk 55 cows, primarily Holsteins with a few Jerseys, in a tie stall facility and breed cattle under the Granvale and Rowspine prefixes. He works alongside his wife Wendy, their sons Sam and Ethan, and his in-laws. They also employ one parttime worker and four part-time students.

The farm spans 350 acres and has been recognized with the "Future of Family Farming Award" from BMO. Lee has previously served as president of several agricultural organizations, including the Wolfe Island Plowman's Association, Frontenac Holstein Club, and Frontenac Soil and Crop. Currently, he is actively involved in a variety of agricultural organizations,

including the Leeds County Soil and Crop, Leeds County Dairy Producer Committee, Leeds County 4-H (as Vice President), Leeds and Grenville Holstein Club (as President), and Lombardy 4-H Dairy Club (as a leader). As a new director, Lee looks forward to learning more about EastGen and its operations.

Chris McLaren, Zone 10 Director (Oxford, Niagara, Brant, *Haldimand, Norfolk, Wentworth)* 

Chris McLaren operates a 600-acre dairy farm located at Drumbo, ON. The farm milks 115 Holsteins under the Larenwood prefix. The cows are housed in a freestall facility with a parlour, and renovations are underway to transition to robotic milking. Chris's farm employs one full-time and eight part-time staff for both dairy and cropping operations.

Chris holds a B.Sc. (Agr) and an M.Sc. (Dairy Epidemiology). His Larenwood herd has earned the Lactanet/Canwest DHI Management Award in 2014, 2015, and 2016, and the Holstein Canada Master Breeder Award in 2019. He is also involved in Progressive Dairy Operators and contributes to University of Guelph research, both as an advisory member and a participating farm. All of Chris's animals are genomically tested with Elevate®, and he uses OptiMate™ for bull selection.

Chris is passionate about dairy cattle management and genetics. As an EastGen director he hopes to gain further insights into these areas, bringing a unique perspective based on his research, management, and genetics background.
