# Embryo Purchases Fuel Genetic Progress at Holmdale

At Holmdale Holsteins. located near Elmwood, ON, embryo purchases are central to accelerating genetic improvement. The farm's strategic focus is on enhancing its herd through careful genetic investments, aimed long-term progress and profitability.

By incorporating Semex Holmdale has embryos, built comprehensive genetics program. purchased thirty farm 0200HO07956 3Star OH Ranger-Red embryos from Semex, specifically targeting improvements Lifetime Production Index (LPI) and Robot while Readv™ traits. also emphasizing conformation. approximately one year of age, the best-performing calves were flushed with

sexed semen, yielding promising results.

Although not a goal, an achievement of this initiative was the sale of a 0200HO12546 Progenesis Perky daughter to Semex. Proceeds from this sale are being reinvested into acquiring additional Semex embryos, with the goal of flushing the best daughters from the Ranger-Red females once they mature. The farm's approach is not focused on commercialization, but rather on continually enhancing the herd's genetic potential.



Most of the Ranger-Red donors are now milking, and the **Progenesis** Perky and 0200HO12574 Progenesis **Popnlock** heifers are still in the calf Holmdale also stage. acquired six heifers from the Progenesis program, which have become valuable assets to the herd.

works closely with farm owner Todd, his sons, Keaton and Chapman, and daughter Grace (currently away at university), to ensure their genetic objectives are met. SemexWorks™ is used to select the appropriate bulls and OptiMate to determine which cattle get which sire assigned to them.

The farm spans 1,500 acres and milks 180 Holsteins in a modern

compost-bedded pack barn equipped with milking robots. The herd currently averages 38 litres of milk per day, with a fat content of 4.2% and protein content of 3.48%. Official milk recording and type classification are also employed to monitor ongoing progress. According to Drew Tyler, "This operation is one of the fastest genetically improving herds in Ontario. Semex embryos play a pivotal role in the farm's genetics strategy. They're not only investing in genetics to increase profits, but they're also building a long-term relationship with EastGen. Their ultimate goal is to boost milk sales through healthier, higher-performing cows." Todd adds, "We purchase embryos to accelerate our LPI and leap ahead by a generation or two in genetic progress."

#### **Genomics and Tailored Breeding Strategy**

Holmdale Holsteins employs advanced genomic testing through Semex's Elevate program to assess the genetic potential of their herd. "We genomically test everything with Elevate," Todd explains. "Then, we use OptiMate to identify the best bulls for our herd, ensuring that our genetic decisions are well-informed. We also collaborate closely with EastGen consultants to select the optimal bulls for each animal."

The results speak for themselves. "We no longer have sick cows, nothing like we used to," Todd says. "The herd's immunity has dramatically improved thanks to genetics. Over the last five years, this progress has been remarkable, and the health of our cows is just incredible." Todd continues, "The Progenesis calves have been a real success for us. We've added some outstanding animals to our herd, leading us to purchase more embryos to introduce fresh genetics and further accelerate genetic progress. The outcomes have been overwhelmingly positive. Now, we have the capability to create our own embryos and perform flushes. It's been an extremely successful strategy."

#### **Long-Term Vision: Fewer Cows, Greater Efficiency**

Looking ahead, Holmdale's long-term goal is to achieve guota with fewer cows, focusing on high-performing animals that require minimal maintenance. "We're aiming for cows that produce milk efficiently, with high fat content, and require less care," Todd concludes.
